How to Collect a Clean-catch Urine Sample for Women




1 Wash your hands with soap and water.



2 Label the container with your name, date of birth, and the date and time of collection.




3 If you are menstruating, insert a fresh tampon to stop the flow. If you can't use a tampon, inform your provider's office or lab caregivers.



4 Open the urine specimen cup. Do not touch the inside of the cup.



5 Open a moist towelette.



6 Separate the skin folds around the urinary tract opening. Wipe the opening and skin folds from front to back. Throw away the towelette. Clean 2 more times using a new towelette each time.



7 Pee into the toilet for a few seconds.



Place the specimen cup into the path of the urine stream. Fill the cup halfway with urine.



9 Wipe off the cup and tightly screw on the lid. Place in the designated area. Wash hands.
